World Environment

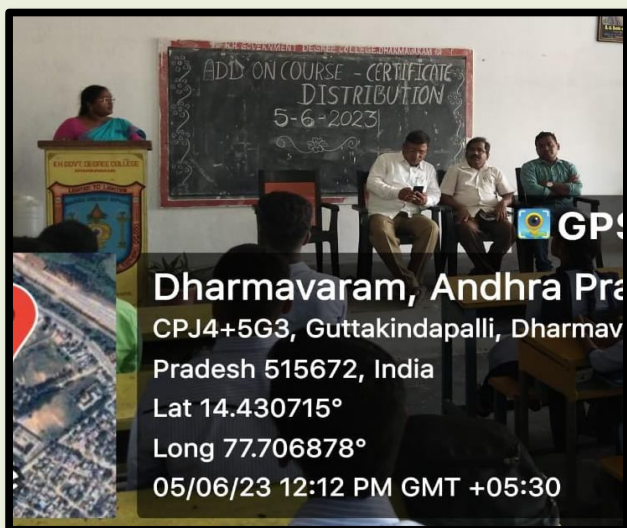
Day 5, Jun 2023

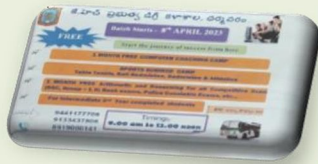


PARTICIPATION OF STUDENT IN CM CUP Competitions 01-05 May, 2023

Prabhakar Reddy, Principal of the College paid tribute to the great personality by garlanding his portrait and praised the tiresome journey of Babasaheb Ambedhkar who strived for establishing secularism and equality among the people of India who are divided in the name of religion and caste. He was also a great economist who had a vision of the country 50 years ahead and proposed various measures in upbringing the economic status of the Country after independence.

He also believed that Democracy is not merely a form of government but it is a primary mode of associate living of conjoint communicated experience. It is essentially an attitude of respect and reverence towards fellowmen. He was the first Indian to pursue Doctorate. He learnt 9 languages and studied across the world for 21 years. His is the only statue placed in the London Museum along side of the statue of Karl Marx even today.

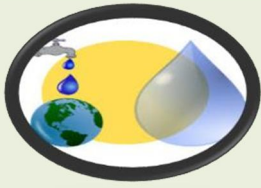

As per the World Water Report by UNESCO, the usage of water has been increased by 1 % per year over the last 40 years.

It has been estimated that the water scarcity faced by urban population will grow from 933 million to 1.7 – 2.4 billion people in 2050

Over the decades, it has been observed that water – energy – food – ecosystem is a powerful approach to address the water problems. Over 2 billion people world wide are unable to access safe drinking water even in 2020s and more than half of the World's population is experiencing severe water crisis all through the year these problems are going to increase by time. However less than 1 % part of the water is fresh and usable for drinking but due to climatic changes that are taking place are affecting this water resource as per the SDG Report 2022.

In order to address these issues to the students S. Pavani, Lecturer in Physics has prepared online quiz to inform the students about the severity of the situation. The effect of this issue is more in drought prone areas like Ananthapur, Sri Sathya Sai District of Andhra Pradesh.

As per UNICEF's report, 1 in 4 children live in extreme drought conditions by 2040. Chennai, is the first Indian city to use recycled waste water. A total of 125 students have participated in the quiz from various colleges in Andhra Pradesh.

As a part of the camp, the volunteers divided into teams each team having 4 members and conducted survey in the adopted village, Gotluru. Most of the villagers are occupied with agriculture and silk saree weaving which is profitable in the locality due to the adequate water resource for farming and the popularity for Dharmavaram silk sarees has been a beneficiary occupation for the youth of this village and have young entrepreneurs in this area who export sarees to other states, big shopping malls etc.,.

Day 1 : The survey is carried out in the area of Gotluru after inauguration programme at Gotluru Sachivalayam in the presence of Dr. K. Prabhakar Reddy, Principal, Dr. T . Jeevan Kumar, Pitta Narasamma Gram Sarpanch Vice- Sarpanch A. Gangadhar and the NSS volunteers. The volunteers were given general instructions for carrying out survey the way of approach to an unemployed, college dropouts or discontinued individuals of the age between 15 an 29 years.

Day 2 : The survey conducted on second day being Sunday, yielded good set of members as it is holiday and each volunteer team could complete three survey forms pertaining to unemployment and education. Day 3 : The NSS Volunteers assembled at Gram Sachivalayam at Gotluru and the teams were dispersed for conducted survey in the adopted village Gotluru. In the premises of mandal Parishad Model Primary School, Gotluru. Each team has conducted a survey for 3 families. The Survey questionnaire was sent by the government of India and have 40 questions to be answered by the individual which includes the standard data like Adhaar Number, Home address, number of family members and the data pertaining to socio, cultural and economics status fo the individual including the marital status.



Day 4 : The fourth day of the camp was dedicated to the cleaning programme conducted before the sachivalayam premises which is a cloud of offices that included DR. YSR raithu bhariosa centre in it.

All the NSS Volunteers cleaned up the mess before these two buildings and in the premises of Mandal Parishad Model Primary School thus promoting Cleanliness by virtue under the guidance of Dr. B. Gopal Naik, NSS coordinator, B. Anand, Physica I Director and T. Ram Mohan Reddy, Guest Faculty in Computer Applications.

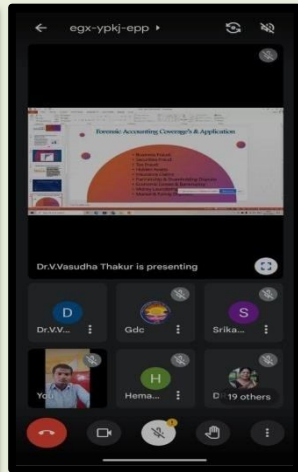
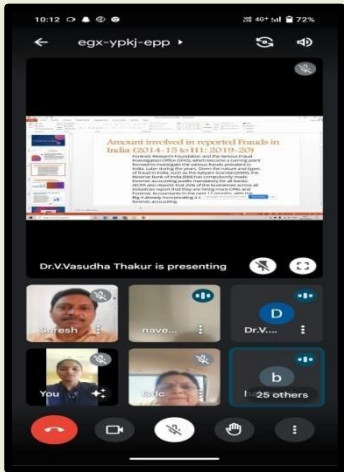

The objective of the exhibition is to tag along the rural sections of the society into the technically advanced world. To spread awareness among the public about the work being carried out by ISRO related to space science and job opportunities in space science. The program is organized by the College under the guidance of Dr. K. Prabhakar Reddy, Principal and Sri C. Muralidhar, DGM, SDSC (ISRO).

A documentary is played to the visitors highlighting ISRO's missions including the Gaganyaan Programme and Chandrayaan – 3 mission. Dr. Vikram Sarabhai, who is known as the Father of the Indian Space Programme foreseen the potential in space science in finding solutions in today's world. Initially, the Indian space program significant work carried on Communication satellite, remote sensing and space transportation system. The Indian space research centre was first established under the Department of Atomic Energy, as the Indian National Committee for Space Research in 1962 with main office at Thumba of Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala. The Indian satellite launch program is initiated with Aryabhata placing it in low earth orbit.

ISRO has launched 123 spacecraft missions, 88 launch missions 13 student satellites, Re-entrymissions, 386 foreign satellites this includes 3 nano satellites and 1 micro satellite.

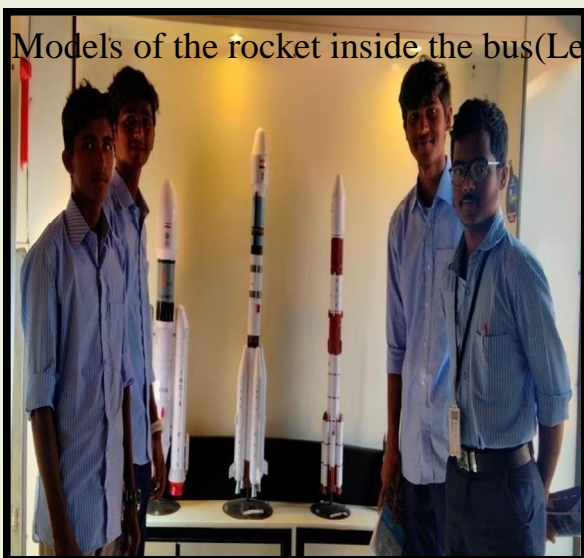

ISRO has 25 sub centres. 3 satellite launching facilities located in Bengaluru, Sriharikota Island and Thiruvananthapuram. The posters displayed in the Science Expo had the types of satellites launched by ISRO till now , parts of a rocket, types of fuel used, process of telecommunication carried out using satellites over the globe. Uses of satellites for communication, weather forecasting, defence, fishing, finding out natural disasters like tsunamis,, floods etc.,.

The Guest of Honour Smt. Nirmala, Municipal Chairman, Dharmavaram, appreciated the efforts made by the college in organizing such a program benefiting the students of Dharmavaram and promised to sanction RO system for drinking water. 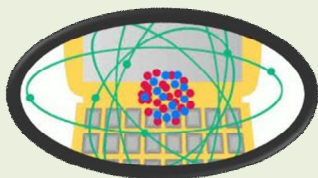
The theme of this year's day is "multilingual education – a necessity to transform education"

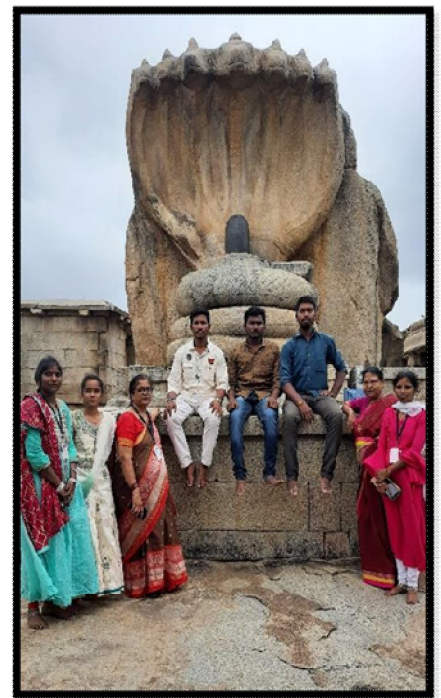
Field Visit to Puttaparti, Lepakshi, & Penukonda

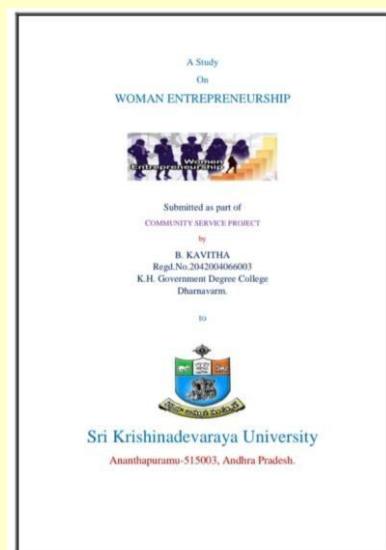
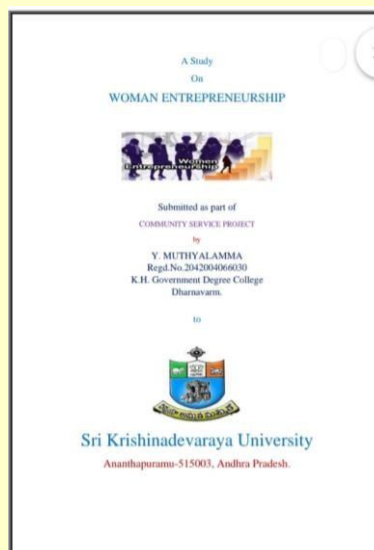
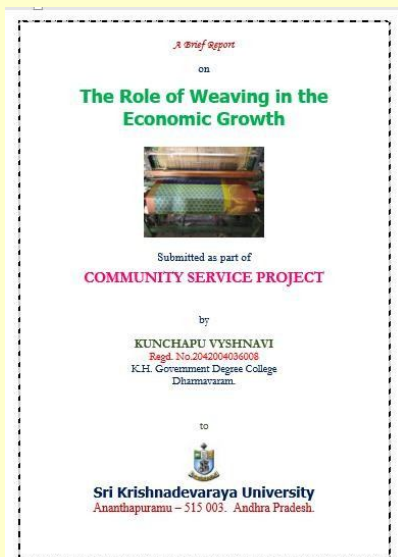
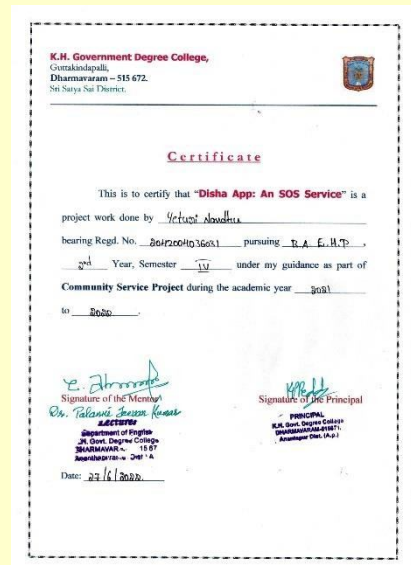
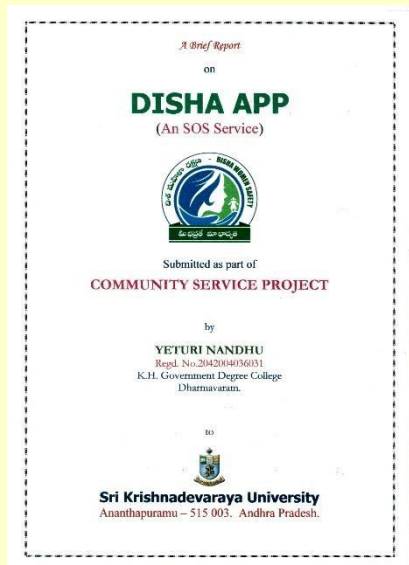


Community Service Project

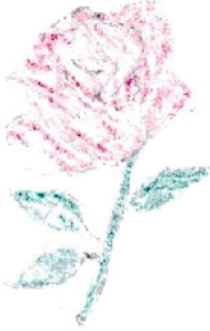

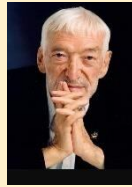

The work of the foundation has helped more than 2.5 million people. It has built 1,700 schools, 30,000 houses and planted 3 million trees. Recently, it has constructed Digital Classrooms, Hostel for Girls, and other classrooms worth 14 crores in Government Polytechnic, Dharmavaram.

Ferrer was awarded with numerous prizes for his humanitarian outlook. He was awarded Spain's Princi of Asturias Concord Prize in 1998. On 1st February 2010, an independent group nominated his name for the 2010 Nobel Peace Prize.

The said organization has donated Sports material worth Rs.50,000/- to K.H. Government Degree College, Dharmavaram, with a view to encouraging the students so that they can do well in games and sports.

On 09-04-2022, the Principal and the Staff have celebrated his birth anniversary to spread the yeoman service and humane quality that he possesses. Principal addressing the gathering said that Ferrar believed the principle of "Service to human is service to God" till the last breath of his life. Even today various institutions working under RDT are rendering their service under the guidance of his beloved wife Anne Ferrer, daughter-in-law Vishali Ferrer, and son Mancho Ferrer.

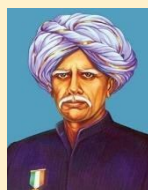


131st Birth Anniversary of DR. B.R. AMBEDKAR

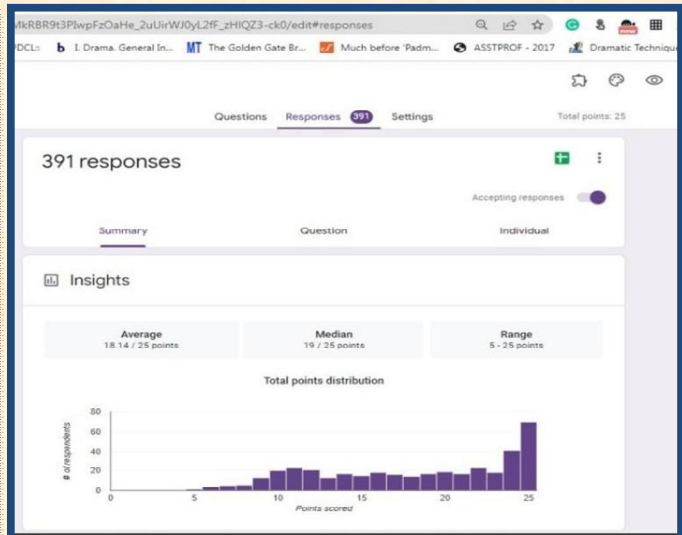

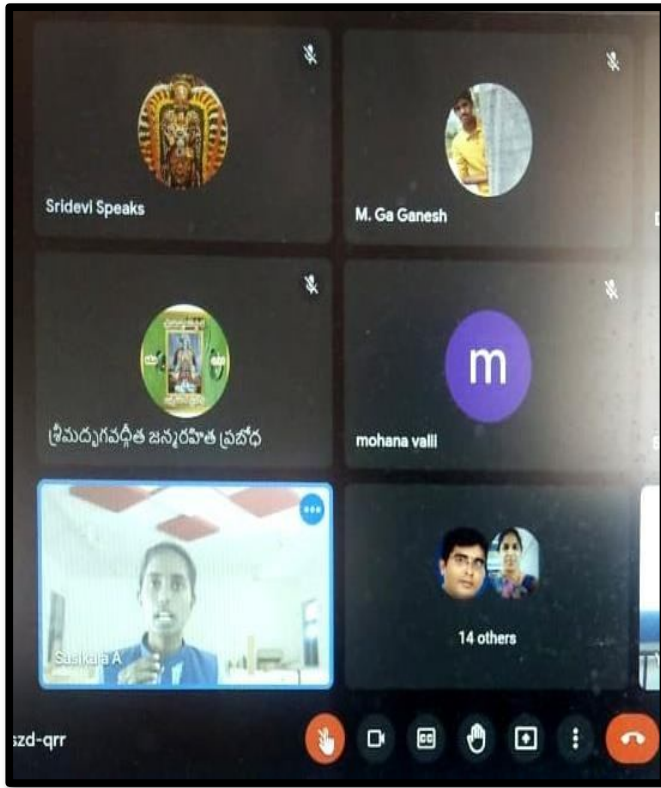

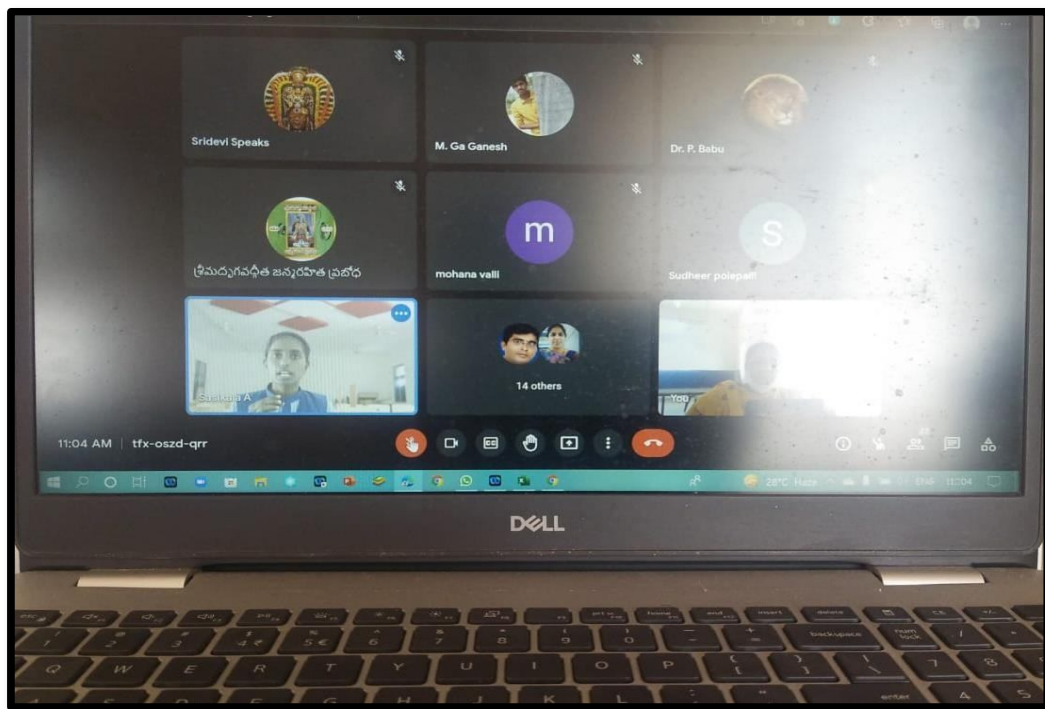
