The Constitution of India has taken around 2 years, 11 months and 17 days to complete. It states that India is a Sovereign, Socialist, Secular, Democratic, Republic that promotes Equality, Liberty and justice to the citizen's of India. The Constituent Assembly appointed 22 committees in preparing the Constitution. Out of which 8 are Main Committees. Dr. Ambedhkar is appointed as the Chairman of Drafting Committee with Gopal Swamy Ayyangar, Alladi Krishnaswamy Ayyar, Dr.K.M. Munshi, Syed Mohammad Saadullah Madhava Rau, T. Krishnamachari. Out of 389 Constituent Assembly members 15 were women. The Constitution consists of 470 articles classified into 25 categories Dr. K. Prabhakar Reddy, Principal, Dr. T. Jeevan Kumar, Vice – Principal, M. Bhuvaneshwari and Dr. B. Gopal Naik, Lecturer in Political Science presided over the function.
