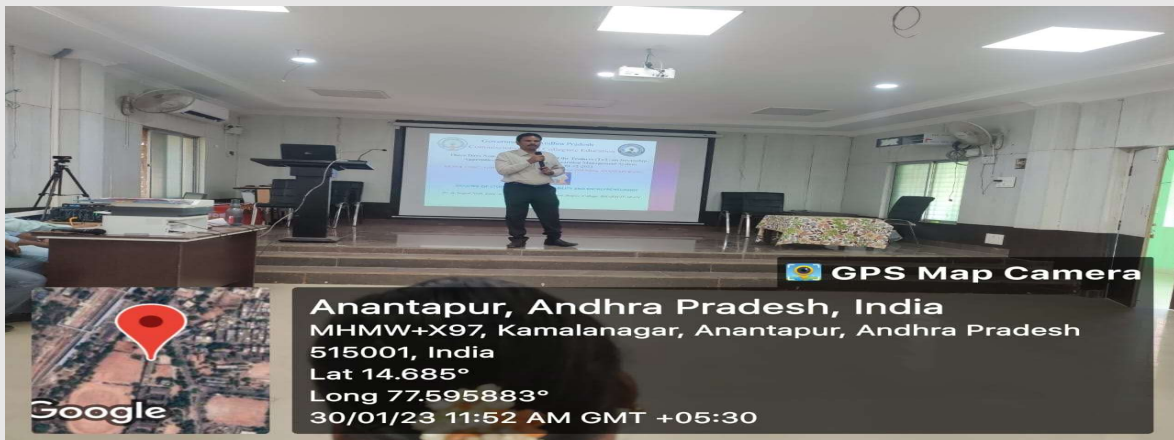

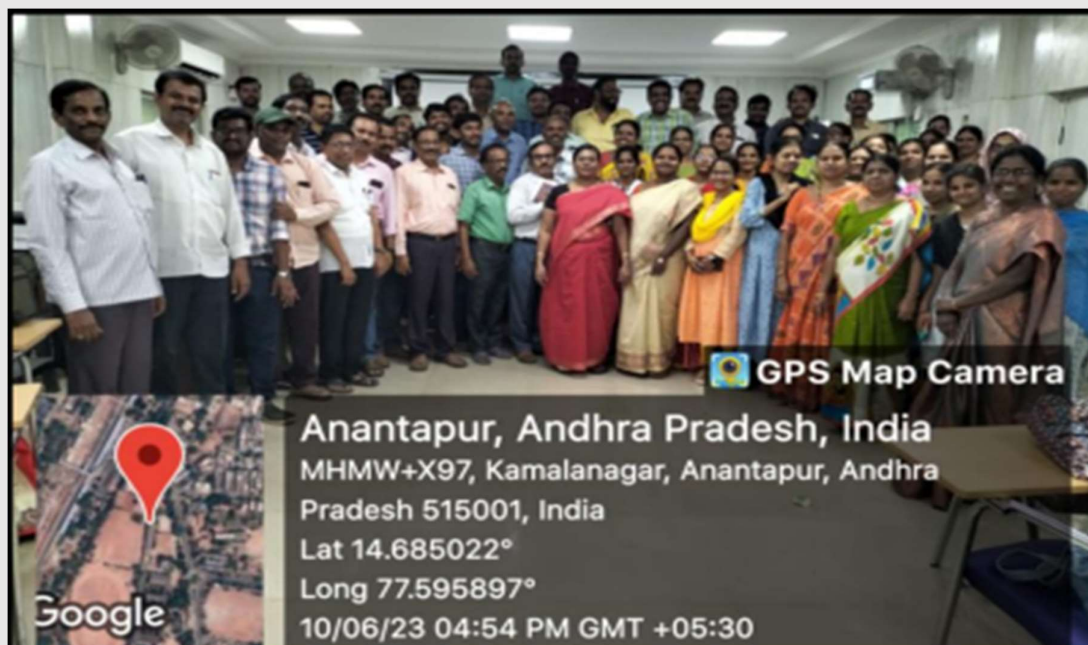
Dr. B. Gopal Naik, Lecturer in Political Science got selected for Master Trainer Program.

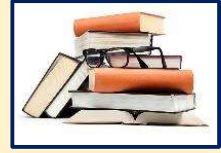
